2 centers of the same size 100 counselings/year 10,000 counselings/year

?



Annual reports to funding administrations

different administrations, different ways of counting different things

Same wording for different things

⇒ Apples and oranges



Administration orders evaluation by external institute

Different organizations (size, topic, approach, techniques...)

Standardized questionnaire No unified definitions



First conclusion:

Don't evaluate us but evaluate with us!



Second conclusion:

- Unified definitions, but no standardized questionnaire
- Adjustment to specific situations
- Resources for those, who gather data



Third conclusion:

- Separation of statistical reports from research on service utilization
- Anonymity
- Participation out of own interest



Integration of

- Service organizations
- Users
- Non-users



Summary

- Aim: improve services (and not cut budgets)
- Participation, integration
 - → higher accuracy of data
- No more fruit-baskets
